REPORT ON THE VISIT TO THE FOUR HEALTH CENTRES IN IJEBU IMUSIN ON MONDAY 24TH MARCH 2025, ON BEHALF OF IPB LAGOS BRANCH, INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE

There are four health facilities in Ijebu Imusin.

The two in Imusin 1 are

Igbaga Health Center and

Ehinade Health Center.

The other two in Imusin 2,

Maternity center and

Ilodo Health Center.

Medication is bought from the Central Medical store, Abeokuta.

- Imusin 1 and Imusin 2 health wards/zones are each headed by Focal Heads, while each of the health centers are headed by Heads of Facility.
- The Focal Head in the Maternity center, Imusin 2, doubles as the Head of Facility.
- The Focal Head, Imusin 1 is in the Igbaga Health center.

Details of Needs

Water: There is a functioning borehole, but pipe replacement needed because old pipes are rusted and water not coming out in some areas.

Light: currently one day on, one day off. Need prepaid meter. February bill was 27,000.00 considered too high. Need solar for night work. Dedicated Solar provided by WHO for vaccines working

Laboratory: need windows, generator, affected by flooding

Phamacy: former Dispensary given to Amotekun. Need fridge, wash hand basin, bed, tables and chairs, solar for night work.

Out Patient dept: need a new building with consulting room and observation room. Currently managing with another unit. Will need need chairs, tables, beds, cabinets, fan.

Injection room: trolleys

Dressing room: plumbing. Water doesn't get there Matrons office: no table and chairs, no fridge

Staff Quarters: needs a kitchen with equipment. Has only 3 beds

Delivery room: no beds, drip stands

Roofs: many leaking

Windows: need net and burglary

Wards: no beds

OGSHIA benefit Insurance package: free treatment was allocated to Ilodo health center. Maternity center was told to look for paying patients. 12k annually per patient, 48k annually per family. So looking for people to financially sponsor some patients who cant afford health care.

OBSERVATIONS

Amotekun taking up some of their space

The Maternity center needs facility maintenance so that current empty rooms can be put to proper use.

The plastic chairs and tables were bought by the staff. They say when they are posted out, they will take their property.

The borehole for Agricultural development by Ogun State Govt is in their premises but no longer working.
